After graduation, students experiencing homelessness face financial burdens and can benefit from additional support as they begin the next chapter of their education. Through the Crossroad Kits initiative, Pennsylvania equips graduating seniors identified for McKinney-Vento with the materials they need to begin higher education and career training confidently.

Homeless Liaisons can actively support college and career transitions for McKinney-Vento students by providing Crossroad Kits.

Kits may include:

- desk and room fittings.
- durable backpack and duffle bag.
- hygiene, toiletry, and comfort items.
- needed technology.

Local Education Agencies (LEAs) may use American Rescue Plan Homeless Children and Youth (ARP-HCY) funds to support this initiative.
