

Pennsylvania ECEYEH Awareness Week November 11 – 15, 2024



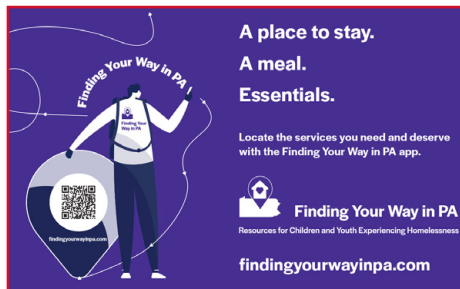
