Support for students experiencing homelessness is improving and meets a critical need.	
Over the last 5 years...	% Change between 2019-20 & 2023-24
Grade 12 Graduation Rate 67.9% in 2019-20 to 70.3% in 2023-24	↑ 4%
Grade 12 Dropout Rate 7.5% in 2019-20 to 6.0% in 2023-24	↓ 11%
% Receiving Individualized Services 74% in 2019-20 to 85% in 2023-24	↑ 14%
Remain in School of Origin 89% on average over 5 years	— Sustained Impact
Score Advanced/Proficient in Math 12.8% in 2020-21 to 15.4% in 2023-24	↑ 6%
